Repair, Replace, Repurpose, Recycle Policy

We try and strike a reasonable balance between the expectations of our guests that their accommodation will be in aesthetically and functionally good order, the inevitable environmental cost of replacing things and the often improved efficiency but shorter life span of newer models.

Subject to the above, where possible we will favour repair over replacement.

We try to make sure we source our goods and services from local suppliers to support the local economy and cut down on transportation costs.

We try and make sure that the goods we buy are manufactured by ethical suppliers that pay their employees fair and liveable wages.

We source our white goods from a local supplier and try to purchase quality goods which will last.

You, our guests, can help us with this by taking extra care of the equipment within our railway carriages. If you are unsure of how something works, please consult the Information for Guests file and if that doesn't help call Dave on 07776 261277. Please let us know of anything not working as expected.

We do try and repurpose many of the items that come to their end of life in the railway carriages, for example duvets are generally put to a second life of providing shed insulation and as padding under pond liners and green roof membranes.

Where repair or repurposing are not practicable, we recycle whatever can be recycled through licensed operators.
